The George Mitchel and Aaron Wilkins Scholarship Fund was established in 2000 to provide assistance to current University of Michigan students who have participated in the Big Sibs Program, which is part of the LS&A Psychology Department's Project Outreach program. Each year, one student who excels in the program will be chosen to receive this scholarship.

Eligibility

University of Michigan students who are participating in the Big Sibs Program for the current academic year, and who have demonstrated financial need and high academic achievement, are eligible for this scholarship.

How to Apply

- Submit a 2008-2009 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to the federal processor at www.fafsa.ed.gov. Be sure to list Federal School Code 002325 so that a copy will be sent to the University of Michigan-Ann Arbor.
- Submit a statement of interest in the scholarship and a letter of recommendation from your group leader to your GSI.

Selection

Each year, the University of Michigan's Office of Financial Aid will review the list of students who have participated in the Big Sibs Program and select the student who best meets the scholarship's eligibility criteria.

Deadline

The University of Michigan's Office of Financial Aid must receive your FAFSA record from the federal processor by April 30 to consider you for this scholarship; allow two to three weeks for the processor to send your record to the Office of Financial Aid.

Notification

Selection of the recipient will be announced by June 1.

Number/Amount

- One scholarship is awarded each year. The scholarship is nonrenewable.
- The amount of the scholarship varies, depending on the annual income from the endowment fund. The minimum amount of the scholarship is \$1,000.
