This scholarship was established in 2003 through a gift from an anonymous donor. The purpose of the scholarship is to enable graduates of Finney High School and Southeastern High School (Detroit) who have superior academic achievement and substantial financial need to attend and graduate from the University of Michigan-Ann Arbor.

Eligibility

Graduates of Finney High School or Southeastern High School in Detroit who have superior academic achievement and substantial financial need are eligible for this scholarship. Students must be admitted to the University of Michigan-Ann Arbor by February 1 of their senior year in high school.

Selection

Each year, the University of Michigan's Office of Financial Aid will review the list of Finney High School and Detroit Southeastern High School graduates who are admitted to the university by February 1 and select one or two students who meet the donor's requirements and have demonstrated financial need.

Deadlines

- The Office of Financial Aid recommends that students apply for admission to the university by **December 1** in order to be considered for admission by February 1.
- **Submit a 2009-2010 CSS/Financial Aid PROFILE application.** The PROFILE is available at <https://profileonline.collegeboard.com> beginning October 1, 2008. Be sure to list CSS Code 1839 so that a copy will be sent to U-M.
- **Submit a 2009-2010 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to the federal processor.** The FAFSA is available at www.fafsa.ed.gov beginning January 1, 2009. Be sure to list the University of Michigan-Ann Arbor and the Federal School Code 002325 so that a copy will be sent to U-M.

Notification

Selection of the scholarship recipient(s) will be announced by April 1.

Number/Amount

- The number of scholarships awarded each year varies.
- The amount of the scholarship varies.
- The scholarship is renewable for three more years of undergraduate study at the University of Michigan-Ann Arbor provided the recipient maintains satisfactory academic progress toward a degree.
