### ELIGIBILITY:

- This scholarship is based on **FINANCIAL NEED**. If you do not qualify for need-based financial aid, you will not be eligible for this scholarship. Financial need and academic standing will be considered in the selection process for all LaVerne Noyes scholarship applicants.
- Recipients of this scholarship must be direct descendants of American veterans of World War I. The veteran must have served for at least six months prior to the Armistice of November 11, 1918, unless he or she was in active service overseas before the Armistice or died while in service.
- Recipients must be enrolled full-time in a degree-granting undergraduate program at the University of Michigan–Ann Arbor campus.

### APPLICATION PROCEDURES & REQUIREMENTS:

To apply for this scholarship, complete steps 1 and 2:

1. **Submit the following to the Office of Financial Aid** by February 26, 2010, at 5:00 p.m.:
  - a. The **scholarship application** (see page 2)
  - b. **Official documentation to verify the military service** of the veteran on whom the application is based (i.e., photocopies of enlistment record, honorable discharge certificate, and/or certification letter from the Veteran's Administration)
  - c. **Documentation verifying the blood relationship** (lineage). Acceptable documents include photocopies of marriage licenses and/or birth certificates of the student, parent, and grandparents.
2. **Apply for financial aid** (*late financial aid applicants will not be considered for this award*):
  - a. Submit a **2010-2011 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** to the federal processor by March 1, 2010. The FAFSA is available on the web beginning January 1, 2010, at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). Be sure to list Federal School Code 002325 so that a record will be sent to U-M.
  - b. Complete the **2010-2011 CSS/Financial Aid PROFILE** application. The PROFILE is available on the web at <https://profileonline.collegeboard.com> beginning October 1, 2009. Be sure to list CSS Code 1839 so that a record will be sent to U-M.

### PLEASE NOTE:

- The application deadline for the LaVerne Noyes Scholarship is **February 26, 2010 by 5:00 p.m.** Applications will not be considered after this date.
- Scholarship applicants will be notified by March 31, 2010, if they are eligible to receive the award.
- This scholarship is not available for Spring/Summer terms.
- The dollar amount of the scholarship is determined by the total number of recipients each year.
