Jeffrey A. Mayer established the Mayer Family Scholarship in 2008 for New York City Public School graduates who have performed well academically. The scholarship serves to help defray the cost of tuition, room and board, and other educational expenses incurred while attending the University of Michigan.

Eligibility

Graduates from the New York City Public Schools who have superior academic achievement and substantial financial need are eligible for this scholarship.

Selection

Each year, the University of Michigan's Office of Financial Aid will review the list of graduates from the New York Public Schools and select the student who best meets the scholarship's eligibility criteria.

Deadlines

- The Office of Financial Aid recommends that students apply for admission to the university by **December 1** in order to be considered for admission by February 1.
- **Submit a 2009-2010 CSS/Financial Aid PROFILE application.** The PROFILE is available at <https://profileonline.collegeboard.com> beginning October 1, 2008. Be sure to list CSS Code 1839 so that a copy will be sent to U-M.
- **Submit a 2009-2010 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to the federal processor.** The FAFSA is available at www.fafsa.ed.gov beginning January 1, 2009. Be sure to list the University of Michigan-Ann Arbor and the Federal School Code 002325 so that a copy will be sent to U-M.

Notification

Scholarship recipient(s) will be notified by April 15.

Number/Amount

- One \$30,000 scholarship will be awarded each year.
- This scholarship is renewable for three additional years of undergraduate study at the University of Michigan-Ann Arbor (for a total of 8 semesters), provided the recipient maintains satisfactory academic progress toward a degree.
