Through the generosity of John Stefan, the Lather Stefan Memorial Scholarship was established to provide scholarships to students from Reed City High School who are admitted to or enrolled in certain fields of study at the University of Michigan. If there are no graduates from Reed City High School admitted to or enrolled at the University of Michigan, consideration will be given to the following area high schools, respectively: Union High School in Grand Rapids, and high schools in Osceola, Mecosta, Newaygo Lake, and Kent counties.

### Eligibility

---

One scholarship will be awarded each year to a student who:

- is admitted to or enrolled in any academic department within the College of Engineering, or admitted to or enrolled in the College of Literature, Science, and the Arts and majoring in or planning to major in one of the following fields of science: Astronomy, Biology, Chemistry, Geology, Mathematics, Physics, Physiology, or Zoology;
- is a graduating senior from Reed City High School or an enrolled student at the University of Michigan who has graduated from Reed City High School;
- is a U.S. citizen and a Michigan resident; and
- has demonstrated need for funds to attend the University of Michigan as defined by the Office of Financial Aid.

### Selection

---

Each year, the University of Michigan's Office of Financial Aid will review the list of eligible students and select the student who best meets the scholarship's eligibility criteria.

### Deadlines

---

- The Office of Financial Aid recommends that students apply for admission to the university by **December 1** in order to be considered for admission by February 1.
- **Submit a 2009-2010 CSS/Financial Aid PROFILE application.** The PROFILE is available at <https://profileonline.collegeboard.com> beginning October 1, 2008. Be sure to list CSS Code 1839 so that a copy will be sent to U-M.
- **Submit a 2009-2010 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to the federal processor.** The FAFSA is available at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov) beginning January 1, 2009. Be sure to list the University of Michigan-Ann Arbor and the Federal School Code 002325 so that a copy will be sent to U-M.

### Notification

---

Scholarship recipient(s) will be notified by March 31.

### Number/Amount

---

The amount of the scholarship varies, depending on the annual income from the endowment fund.
