This scholarship fund was established by Harold and Annette Stieg of Bloomfield Hills, Michigan, in honor of Mr. Stieg's parents. Elmer C. Stieg served as a Lutheran minister in the Bad Axe area for more than 21 years. He and his wife, Louise, lived in the Bad Axe area until 1947. All four of their children attended Bad Axe High School. Harold received his B.A. from the University of Michigan in 1949 and his J.D. from the University of Michigan Law School in 1951. Annette Dieters Stieg received her B.A. from the University of Michigan in 1948.

### Purpose

The scholarship encourages and assists graduates of public high schools in Huron County, Michigan, to attend the University of Michigan by providing need-based scholarships to top students. Preference is given to students from Bad Axe High School.

### Eligibility

Scholarships will be awarded each year to students who:

- are graduating seniors of public high schools in Huron County, Michigan;
- are admitted to an undergraduate program at the University of Michigan–Ann Arbor;
- demonstrate financial need, as defined by the Office of Financial Aid; and
- are U.S. citizens and Michigan residents.

### Selection

Each year, the University of Michigan's Office of Financial Aid will review the list of graduating seniors from public high schools in Huron County and select the student who best meets the scholarship's eligibility criteria.

### Deadlines

1. Students must be admitted to the University of Michigan by to February 1, 2009.
2. A 2009-2010 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) must be completed between January 1 and March 15, 2009, specifying that information be released to the University of Michigan–Ann Arbor (Federal School Code 002325). The FAFSA is available at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov).
3. A 2009-2010 CSS/Financial Aid PROFILE application must be completed between October 1, 2008, and March 15, 2009, specifying that the information be released to the University of Michigan–Ann Arbor (CSS Code 1839). The PROFILE is available at <https://profileonline.collegeboard.com>.
4. No separate scholarship application is required.

### Notification

The Office of Financial Aid will notify scholarship recipients by May 1. High school counselors will also be notified of the winners.

### Amount

The Stieg Scholarship provides up to \$7,500 per year for up to four years or eight semesters, provided the student continues to make satisfactory academic progress and to demonstrate financial need.
